

# Chickens have feelings, too.

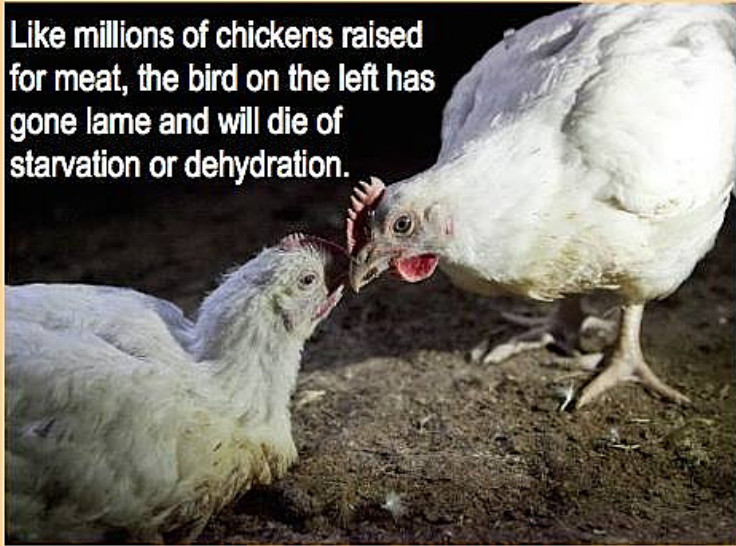
Hens used for eggs are raised in cages then killed at only 18-24 mos.



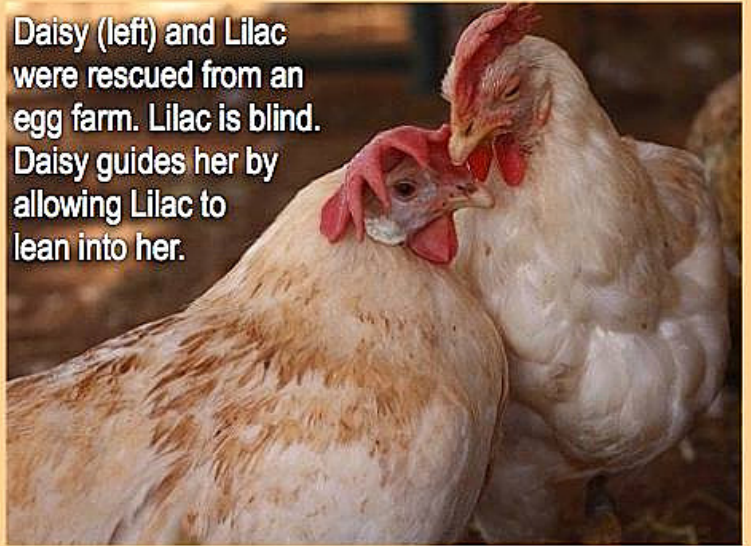
Terrified on a transport truck to slaughter. Chickens killed for meat are only 6-7 weeks old.
